### **Conditions of participation for riders**

TREC 40: Minimum age 16 years (on the first day of the competition), participation possible as an individual rider or in a team. Difficulty level “difficult”, distance ca. 40 km.

TREC 30: Minimum age 16 years (on the first day of the competition), participation possible as an individual rider or in a team. Difficulty level “medium”, distance ca. 30 km.

TREC 20: Minimum age for individual riders: 16 years (on the first day of the competition),  
and 20E minimum age for riders in a team: 14 years. Children under 14 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.  
Difficulty level “easy”, distance ca. 20 km.

**For minors, we require the written consent of the legal guardian.** All categories can be ridden as an individual rider or in a team (two riders).

### **Conditions of participation for horses**

TREC 40: At least 6 years

TREC 30: At least 5 years

TREC 20: At least 5 years

**Helmets are required for all competitions and wearing a body protector (level 3) is required during the PTV competition.** During the POR, carrying the following items is mandatory: Original ID card, copy of the horse passport, high-visibility vest, halter and rope. Communication devices may only be carried in packaging by judges. Speedometers, odometers and GPS are prohibited.

**Scale of the map:** 1:25.000

### **Vaccination**

Influenza vaccination is recommended, but not mandatory.

### **Horse passport**

Any horse competing in national competitions or competitions in other countries must have a valid official FEI passport or a national passport to identify the horse and document ownership. All horses must be registered and identified.


### **Rules and regulations für competitors**

This event is organized according to the international FITE-rules for TREC. By entering, all participants accept the TREC rules of FITE as well as the WBO of the German Equestrian Federation and of the federal commissin of Baden-Württemberg. Disclaimer - Any recourse to the organizer, their collaborators and their assistants is excluded. The veterinary inspection gives no guarantee of keeping the horses health.

### **Riders' insurance**

Every competitor is responsible for any damage caused by himself or his horse, to himself, other people, or any property.

**Every competitor has to have sufficient liability insurance. It must be valid for competitions in foreign countries.**



### Route description POR:

You can expect a varied route that will lead through streams which must be forded and forded without the option to go around them. Don't worry, your horses won't need flotation devices; the water won't be very deep. 😊

### Difference between TREC 20 and TREC 20E at our event:

The TREC 20E is particularly suitable for riders who want to try or learn TREC riding. Your horses must be sure-footed and in good condition, and you must be able to ride your horse safely in all gaits on open terrain. For the 20E, riders receive a pre-drawn map with a marked coordinate. In the "regular" TREC 20/30/40, additional challenges such as a blind map or marching numbers may be included alongside the coordinates. Furthermore, the time limits for the riding test (MA) are significantly relaxed for the "E" level, and the course length is shortened to 100 meters. Otherwise, the MA rules are identical to TREC 20/30/40 (changes of gait, crossing the line, etc.). The PTV obstacles/tasks for TREC 20 and TREC 20E are identical. However, in the TREC 20E, we also award points if certain tasks are completed at a walk instead of a trot or canter.

### The TREC participation fee includes:

Registration fee, Camping, Paddock hay and water incl. (please bring your own material!). Meals are provided from Saturday morning (breakfast) through Sunday noon (lunch). Coffee and tea are available at breakfast and in the afternoon, and mineral water is served with main meals. If you require vegetarian or gluten-free meals, please indicate this on the registration form. Enjoy our fantastic facilities, including a separate, modern shower unit.

We're planning a "Dinner of Nations" for Friday evening and we are looking forward to a diverse buffet, to which we'd appreciate it if you all contributed something. We'll provide complimentary mineral water. Feel free to bring your own alcoholic and non-alcoholic drinks – and your own drinking cups if you like – and celebrate a fantastic TREC event with us in a wonderful atmosphere.

In addition to the participation fee, a deposit for the paddock of €20 must be paid. This will be paid back by the organizer when you leave the cleaned paddock at the end of the event, by bank transfer.

### Publication of photos on our homepage and social media:

By submitting their entry, the participant gives their consent to the publication of personal photos and films. Objections to this can be submitted in writing to the registration office before the first day of the event.


